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01 INTRODUCTION

The Moroccan Youth Diplomats (MYD) is a registered nonprofit organization focused on empowering Moroccan youth by developing their leadership skills, diplomatic knowledge, and fostering active community participation. By establishing an MYD branch, your institution becomes part of an influential network dedicated to positive social impact, civic engagement, and global awareness.

OBJECTIVES OF MYD BRANCHES

Moroccan Youth Diplomats

MYD branches aim to cultivate essential leadership skills, including negotiation, public speaking, and teamwork. They provide practical education on diplomacy, international relations, and political processes. Members gain opportunities to participate in local, national, and international events, and engage in meaningful community service and cultural exchanges. Practical training is delivered through structured simulations, including those of the Moroccan Parliament, United Nations, European Union, African Union, and the US Congress.

ACTIVITIES AND PROGRAMS

MYD branches engage students in various enriching programs, including:

- Leadership and Skill-building Workshops
- Monthly Roundtable Discussions
- Diplomatic and Parliamentary Simulations
- Community Service Initiatives
- Cultural Exchange Events
- Educational Visits to Government Institutions
- Exclusive International Trips and Competitions
- Interactive Summits (specific to university students)

University branches will also have direct support from MYD's Partnerships and External Relations Department, providing legal and advisory assistance for establishing partnerships and organizing activities.





04 ESTABLISHING AN MYD BRANCH

For Highschool students:

High school students are not required initially to obtain formal administrative approval. Instead, students should first gather a committed group interested in joining MYD. Additionally, a teacher must agree to supervise the club activities. Parental consent acknowledging students' inclusion as MYD members and supporting their intention to establish a branch within the school is mandatory.

Once established, MYD's Partnerships and External Relations Department will liaise with the supervising teacher to formalize agreements between MYD, your institution, and the regional education academy governing your school.



For University students:

University students must obtain formal administrative approval from their university administration.

Following this approval, students will collaborate closely with MYD's Partnerships and External Relations Department, which provides comprehensive advisory and legal support for institutional partnerships.

LEGAL & ADMINISTRATIVE REQUIREMENTS

MYD branches must adhere strictly to Moroccan legal frameworks governing associations, student clubs, educational partnerships, fundraising, and data privacy:

- Institutional authorization for all activities on campus.
- Parental consent for participants under 18 years old for off-campus activities.
- Notarized parental approval for minors traveling internationally.
- Transparent financial management, independent from institutional budgets, with regular reporting to MYD's central finance department.
- Compliance with Moroccan Law No. 18.18 governing public fundraising activities.
- Facilities usage approved in writing by school/university administrations, with maintenance and cleanliness protocols observed.

ACTIVITY PLANNING & APPROVAL

Students are encouraged to propose their own activities, provided these align with MYD's goals and respect national guidelines. However, all branch activities must receive prior approval from MYD's board through a general assembly. Proposed activities should:

- Not challenge Islam, national unity, or the constitutional monarchy.
- Align with MYD's vision and objectives.
- Follow internal and external legal guidelines for educational institutions.



04-3 RESPONSIBILITIES & OVERSIGHT

MYD's central organization will provide monthly activity outlines and guidelines to each branch. Any additional independent branch activities proposed by members must receive oversight and approval from MYD's central Board. The appointed teacher advisor (for high school branches) will maintain regular communication with MYD's Partnerships and External Relations Department to ensure all activities and compliance issues are managed effectively.

04-4 SAFETY & INSURANCE

Student safety is paramount. Adult supervision and emergency protocols must always be ensured. MYD provides general insurance coverage for officially approved activities.

COMMUNITY & INSTITUTIONAL ENGAGEMENT

Branches should actively collaborate with Parents' Associations, local government bodies, and educational institutions. Such partnerships will enhance student experiences and provide additional resources for successful program implementation.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

To start the application process, submit:

- A detailed letter of intent signed by participating students.
- Parental consent forms (high school branches).
- Administrative approval (university branches).
- A brief proposal outlining your branch's intended goals, student leadership structure, and any initial activity ideas you may have, subject to final review and approval by MYD's central organization.
